

The Access Bank code is a code that gives you easier access to financial services and offers from Access Bank. The bank code does the following for you.

Send and receive money, top-up your airtime, buy data, check your account balance and so much more. All without the internet!

*901# is your best friend; It is fast, convenient, and secure. It's always available round the clock and saves you the stress of queuing up in the banking halls.

Open a Fresh Account from anywhere

Did you know that by dialling *901*0# and following the prompts, you can either open an account by using your BVN or by providing your personal details as prompted? Upon provision of the required details, you will receive an SMS with details of your new account number.

The good thing is that it doesn't require filling of forms and there is no minimum opening balance.

Check Your Account Balance With *901*00#

To perform this task, simply Dial *901*00# on your Access Bank registered phone number.

After doing this, authenticate using a four (4) digit security code (You can create a security code using the Menu option).

Your account balance is immediately generated after this has been provided.

Protect your Account

When i said the *901# bank code is your best friend, i meant it. The Access bank short code has got you covered even in times of emergencies. In cases of theft or if you lose your card, simply dial *901*911# from any mobile number and your account will be blocked from fraudulent activities.

With or without the internet, you can access financial services using your favourite short code. Don't be left behind, take advantage of your bank's code today.
